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Educational for Drone (eDrone)

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Introduction / Foreword

In each Partner Country, the enrollment process of attendees has been conducted with different procedures. All include an interview phase to select maximum 20 most motivated candidates willing to work in drone civil applications field: these learners will be recruited as trainees, who, once completed the course, will constitute the experts in drone and related technologies and regulatory issues.

1. Description of the enrolment process of the CIA

ARMENIA

The first edition of the CIA course took place during the period February 14th- April 4th, 2020 (was postponed because of pandemic of coronavirus)

All 9 trainees of the first CIA pilot course are 3rd year BA students of Aircraft maintenance and exploitation specialty of National Polytechnic University of Armenia (NPUA).

11 students who had high marks in the Hydraulics, Aerodynamics, Gas dynamics and Avionics were offered to join the first CIA training courses. Finally 9 of them agreed.

The second edition of the CIA course took place during the period March 13th- April 30th, 2020 (was postponed because of pandemic of coronavirus)

The second pilot course was recruited by the Armenian State University of Economics (ASUE) from among students and staff.

BELARUS

The process of admission to the CIA at the Belarusian State University was carried out within the framework of the educational programs of the specialty "Aerospace radio-electronic and information systems and technologies" at the Faculty of Radiophysics and Computer Technologies and the specialty "Nuclear Physics" at the Faculty of Physics.

MOLDOVA

The participants in the first edition were the employees from the companies questioned for user needs identification within the WP2 and employees from the Associate Partners organizations. According to the project description, the first edition of the CIA course was free.

For the second edition (04.03.2019-03.06.2019) the enrolment process was done during different events: Science Day (10 November 2018, student conference (February 2019), exhibitions, etc.) As result, 17 attendees began the 2nd edition of the CIA on March 4, 2019. The enrolment process for the third edition of the CIA courses was done according to the suggestions given by the attendees in the previous editions: the group of attendees for CIA should be more homogeneous in order to improve the courses' quality. In this regard, the 3rd edition was delivered for the employees from the General Inspectorate of Border Police of Republic of Moldova.

The 4th edition of CIA courses was delivered for the attendees from the National Patrol Inspectorate of the Internal Affairs Ministry of the Republic of Moldova.

All participants were registered on the MOODLE platform, where all the course content was uploaded.

Each CIA edition had lasted 7 weeks according to the schedule and finalized with a final test.

GEORGIA

The CIA course in Georgia has been announced in collaboration of Ilia State University and Tbilisi State University. The first edition course Attendees were mainly the university students from ISU(P15) and TSU (P16). The interest was very high. 21 participants were selected for the first Pilot course in Practical Use of Drones.



The announcements about the course were published in various sources. Like Universities' web-pages and Social Media. More than fifty applications were received. The course duration is 5 weeks.

2. Public call performed

ARMENIA

As the first two courses were pilot and formed by the students of NPUA and ASUE no public calls were performed.

BELARUS

Open teleconferences were held for two courses, information was available on the Moodle platform of the Belarusian State University. In this way, university students were able to participate in the course and disseminate information.

GEORGIA

The public calls were performed for both two courses, information was available through Universities' webpages and Facebook pages. So, everyone, not only University students were able to participate in the course and spread the word.

MOLDOVA

For the first edition of the CIA courses no public calls were performed. In this edition were involved specialists from the organisations questioned during the study of user needs in the WP1 and specialists from associated partners of the project.

The other three editions of the CIA courses developed in the OED of MSU by the moldovan partners were advertised during the developed events: Science days in 2018 and 2019, at the exhibition of inventions, conferences, etc. We distributed flyers and leaflets (See the https://drive.google.com/drive/u/1/folders/1do-PI1V3gsW_ac6XxFHWPB-5vRQwikJfj, <https://docs.google.com/presentation/d/1vifragRbZNnJLL28DIk5PDFZgUSMqbT/edit#slide=id.p1>, https://drive.google.com/drive/u/1/folders/1do-PI1V3gsW_ac6XxFHWPB-5vRQwikJfj) and produced short information seminars in order to recruit future attendees.

4. Main criteria used for the selection

ARMENIA

First pilot course - high marks in the following subjects: Hydraulics, Aerodynamics, Gas dynamics and Avionics

Second pilot course -

BELARUS

The main criterion for the selection of participants was high motivation to study drone technology.

GEORGIA

The main criteria for selecting attendees were the interest in drones technology and background in related fields or/and any connections with the drones usage.

MOLDOVA

According to the project description and the user needs report (WP1), the CIA courses are dedicated to the large spectrum of attendees and have been oriented to the professionals from different areas of national economy: agriculture, mass media, archeology, cadastre, etc. All attendees selected for CIA courses were more than 18 years old and used the acquired competence for their professional use.
